

Mental Health Independent Living Skills Program (ILP)

Program Description: Independent Living Skills (ILP) services provide mental health counseling to residents of South Santa Clara County who have been in foster care. Services include outpatient individual, family and/or group therapy, case management services, and medication support services. Services are available to those that meet medical necessity for mental health services. These services are provided to those who have full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families, or no insurance.

Eligibility Criteria: Foster care youth - ages range up to 21 years; full scope Medi-Cal.

Referral Sources/Referral Procedure: Referrals are made through Community Solutions ILP Program or Family and Children Services. A referral form should be completed and then submitted to the assigned clinical coordinator.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: Medi-Cal, Healthy Families with MediCal.
